PASTOR'S POTPOURRI –THE EXALTATION OF THE CROSS

Why are we talking about the cross in September? Today's feast originated in Jerusalem and marks the anniversary of the consecration of the basilica built by the emperor, Constantine in the fourth century. This day is also the celebration of the finding of the true cross by St. Helena, Constantine's mother; and the restoration of that cross to Jerusalem by the emperor Heraclius several hundred years later. But more important these particular historical events is the meaning of the cross for each believer.

Every Good Friday as people come to venerate the cross with reverence, I see old and young, vigorous and lame, shy and assertive, those beautiful by the world's standards and those with inner beauty—all come forward. They each kneel or genuflect or kiss or touch or bow to the cross. And the faces...what expression is given...transparent with joy and sadness, success and failure, longing and desire, despair and hope. Each in his or her own way, coming to the cross...not only to remember the love of our Lord Jesus in offer his life on the cross, but also the ways in which their lives are intertwined with his. This cross is about so many things. Each of us has meaning of one sort or another that is drawn from the cross. In one way, the cross is about acceptance...forgiveness. We hear Jesus in the midst of his passion tell us from the cross: "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

To join our crosses with the cross of Jesus, we must forgive whoever it is we blame for our suffering, even if that blame is heaped upon ourselves or God.

May the Lord increase the meaning what we suffer so that we can say with St. Paul, "I make up in my own flesh for that which is lacking in the suffering of Christ for the sake of his body, the Church." Let the cross be exalted through the witness of our lives.

Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Last week I had the opportunity to be on a jury. When it came time to choose our foreperson we each admitted that if we found her guilty we didn't want to be the one to look her in the eye and say it out. In the end, it didn't matter. They polled each of us, and we each said "guilty". When it was my turn I forced myself to look in her lovely young face and say, "Guilty". I reasoned that if I wasn't certain enough to look her in the eye and say it then I should change my vote. Sometimes we have to look at the very thing that makes us uneasy and name it. I felt my weakling self grow stronger as I met her gaze and spoke the truth that I believed, even while knowing that it would make her life more difficult. But that truth may save her life someday, or the life of a passenger in her car, or in a car sharing the road with her.

Averting our gaze from our own truth—our addictions, our gossiping, our laziness, our self-aggrandizement—only hastens the day when someone else will have to tell us the truth about ourselves. Hopefully, that won't be in a courtroom.

Stare down the serpent as it is raised up in the desert and it will heal you. That's the beginning of true spiritual healing. Recognize and name the things that are making you sick, or sad, or sinful. Have the courage to truly gaze at them, and then watch God heal.

REFLEXION DE LAS LECTURAS DE HOY

Números 21:4b-9. La primera lectura de hoy recuerda uno de los muchos problemas que los israelitas tuvieron en el desierto. Ofrece otro ejemplo de como Dios salvó a su pueblo. Debido a las protestas de los israelitas, el Señor permitió que serpientes venenosas los mordieran y algunos murieron. Esto hizo que el pueblo reconociera su pecado ante Moisés y le pidiera su oración. El Señor pidió a Moisés poner una serpiente en el tope de su bastón para que todo el que había sido mordido por una serpiente sanara. Moisés lo hizo, y todo el que había sido mordido miraba la serpiente y era sanado. Lo importante en esta historia no es el poder mágico de la serpiente de bronce, sino la fe y el arrepentimiento del pueblo y el amor misericordioso de Dios por su pueblo. Más tarde en la historia (Sabiduría 18:5-10) la serpiente de bronce es señalada como signo de la salvación de Dios.

Filipenses 2:6-11. En la segunda lectura, Pablo nos recuerda que: Jesús "Se despojó de su grandeza, tomó condición de esclavo . . . Se humilló a sí mismo, haciéndose obediente hasta la muerte, y una muerte de cruz". Pablo nos anima a seguir el ejemplo de Jesús en nuestra actitud hacia los demás. Como seguidores de Jesús, el tratarnos con la misma bondad y amor de Jesús debería ser una segunda naturaleza. Esto se necesita desesperadamente hoy cuando nuestra cultura nos presenta tantos mensajes diferentes: "piensa en ti", "conviértete en el número 1". Toma un tiempo para pensar en las actitudes que muestras a los demás.

Juan 3:13-17. En el evangelio de hoy Jesús responde las preguntas del fariseo Nicodemo, quien vino a verlo a escondidas una noche. Jesús lo lleva gradualmente a comprender el gran amor de Dios por nosotros. El explica hermosamente que "Dios no envió a su Hijo al mundo para condenarlo, sino para salvarlo". Porque: "tanto amó Dios al mundo que le dio a su único Hijo. . ." (Jn 3:16) En otras palabras, Dios haría cualquier cosa por nosotros.


