
## PASTOR'S POTPOURRI WALKING ON WATER

In today's Gospel passage from Matthew, several things are noted: Jesus needs time away for prayer; the storm is overwhelming the little boat of the disciples; Jesus comes walking on the water and they think they are seeing a ghost; the Lord tells that not to be afraid and says "It is I."; and finally Peter says that if it is really Jesus he should bid him to step out the boat and walk on the water. The amazing thing is, Peter does walk on water as long as his focus is on Jesus. When he is distracted (and who wouldn't be) by the waves and the storm, he takes his attention from Jesus to the plight he is in.

A lesson for us is that we will not walk on water, ever. But in all the storms of life, we need to focus on Jesus, who is always present and helps us in our need. He says to us as he said to the early disciples: "Don't be afraid. It is I." May we have that confidence and grow in our trust in the Lord and in our prayer that unites us to Him.

## Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



I think Peter must have loved Jesus with all his heart and soul and mind and strength. It was that love that compelled him and his brother Andrew to leave their nets behind when Jesus called them to begin his Assembly of Twelve years earlier.

And it was surely that love that pushed Peter out of the wind-tossed boat in the fourth watch of the night. The Romans divided the night into three-hour "watches", four per night. It was now somewhere between 3a.m. and 6a.m., and they were exhausted, terrified, and struggling mightily.

Even though the seasoned fishermen had set out in early evening, they still hadn't crossed the Lake, which is five miles wide, because of the great gales. It was then that Emanuel—*God with us*—set out to be with them in the storm. It was he who had commanded them to get in the boat and return to the other side of the Lake. It was he who stayed behind in a deserted place to pray while they went off to meet the wind and the rain. And it was he who was now coming to comfort them.

This was no still, quiet voice they heard, speaking to their hearts during a quiet retreat. This was the screaming roar of an epic storm at sea. It was in the storm that Jesus drew near to them. And it was in the storm that Peter said, *Lord, if that's really you, just call me and I'll come.*

The next time you are terrified—perhaps of losing someone you love, or of a scary diagnosis—think of Jesus coming toward you in the midnight storm, calling your name. Take heart. It is really he.



## REFLEXION DE LAS LECTURAS DE HOY

1 Reyes 19:9a, 11-13a. Si la "voz" de Dios se pudiera grabar, probablemente la mayoría de la gente pensaría que sonaría potente, como el sonido de un fuerte viento, o sorprendente como el ruido de un trueno o un huracán. El profeta Elías hace un tremendo descubrimiento acerca de Dios. Cuando Dios habló a Elías en la santa montaña, Elías escuchó "un pequeño murmullo". En el sonido, Elías reconoció que Dios estaba presente y que lo protegería de sus enemigos.

Romanos 9:1-5. En esta lectura San Pablo expresa su tristeza porque la mayoría del pueblo no reconoce a Jesús como el Mesías. Sin embargo, Pablo lo sigue amando. Ellos forman el pueblo escogido de Dios, y Pablo reza por ellos.

Mateo 14:22-33. Hay realmente dos historias en el evangelio de hoy. Una acerca de Jesús y la otra acerca de Pedro. El evangelio empieza con Jesús rezando. Sus discípulos están cruzando el mar de Galilea en un bote. En medio de la noche una tormenta zarandea el bote. Justo cuando está a punto de zozobrar, Jesús viene al rescate de sus discípulos. El está caminando sobre las aguas.

La segunda historia nos cuenta sobre la fe de Pedro puesta a prueba. Pedro cree que puede acercarse a Jesús, quien camina sobre las aguas tormentosas. Pero Pedro está fuera del bote, "rodeado por olas amenazadoras", y titubea. En su miedo, empieza a hundirse. Después de salvar a Pedro, Jesús le pregunta por qué dudó y no confió en él.
