

### PASTOR'S POTPOURRI

How about that woman! And what kind of response is that from Jesus? How could he speak to her in the way that he does? This snapshot of his encounter with the Canaanite Woman is one we would like to rip from the pages of the scriptures. How did that poor mother feel? We know that the disciples wanted to get rid of her as she insisted on someone paying attention to her. No one did. Finally, she throws herself at the feet of Jesus and begs that he help her and her daughter.

But the Lord says that dogs can't eat the children's food from the table. And she responds with the famous words, "But even the dogs eat the scraps from the table." As a Canaanite woman she was not Jewish and therefore could be called a "dog" ...not a term of endearment. But her retort to Jesus's seemingly nasty remark, must have made him laugh out loud. She would not take no for an answer no matter what people might say about her or to her.

It gives us courage to know that when we persevere in our prayer we will be heard. And we know that the Lord finally responded to her request (demand). We still have a hard time balancing this incident with the otherwise gentle Jesus that we know. May we continue to trust in his power and goodness. **Msgr. Bob**

### Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time



I hope that you have a lot of memories of your parents pulling a "Syro-Phoenician Woman" for you. I do. One time my dad actually went to the convent and spoke with the principal about me. I came home from the first day of school in fourth grade very upset because all of my friends were in the other section of fourth grade. He came home that night and said, "It's okay, Kathy. I went down and explained everything to Sister. Tomorrow you'll be in the other classroom." That feeling of being extraordinarily loved has never left me.

Imagine that tormented daughter, probably convulsing and having seizures, finally being at rest. Imagine the peace, and the relief, and the immense gratitude she must have felt when the neighbors came running in and said, "You should have seen your mom! She stood right up to the Rabbi. He told her he only came for the Jews, and she told him that even the dogs get the leftovers! And he laughed and laughed, and hugged her, and told her that her faith had blessed him so much that he could feel healing going out from him!" That's how I imagine that conversation went.

I'm positive that daughter never forgot the feeling of being so very precious to her mother that she sought out Jesus as he was passing through her town and begged for her life. I'll bet that wonderful knowledge of how deeply she was loved healed her as much as did the power of Jesus.





## REFLEXION DE LAS LECTURAS DE HOY

Isaías 56:1, 6-7. En esta primera lectura, Isaías señala que Dios quiere que todo el mundo se salve. Dios no hace distinción basada en raza, clase social o situación económica. El profeta afirma que a los ojos de Dios, creer en el Señor y mantener sus mandamientos es lo que importa. Estos son los criterios por lo que seremos juzgados. El gozo del reino de Dios espera por los fieles.

Romanos 11:13-15, 29-32. En esta lectura leemos sobre la discriminación. Los primeros miembros de la Iglesia eran judíos que no estaban dispuestos a aceptar a los no judíos en la Iglesia. San Pablo les recuerda que él es el "apóstol de los gentiles". Esta actitud discriminatoria de los miembros de la Iglesia pavimentó el camino para que Pablo predicara el evangelio a los gentiles. También permitió a los gentiles responder con más facilidad, sin la influencia de la cultura judía. Pablo espera que su ministerio a los gentiles provoque el resurgir de la fe en otros miembros de la Iglesia.

Mateo 15:21-28. En este evangelio Jesús se encuentra con una mujer cananea que le pide ayudar a su hija enferma. Como la mujer es una gentil, los apóstoles quieren despedirla, pero Jesús continúa hablando con ella. Además de su gran fe y valor, la mujer también mostró un tremendo amor por su hija. Ella estaba dispuesta a arriesgarse a ser rechazada por romper las barreras del convencionalismo para pedir ayuda. Ella, verdaderamente, cree que Jesús puede ayudar a su hija y a pesar de que él parece reacio, ella no está dispuesta a desistir. Ella persiste, le implora. Eventualmente Jesús alaba su inquebrantable fe y sana a su hija. Jesús contesta con algo que a todos nos gusta escuchar: "Mujer, grande es tu fe, que sea como has pedido".

### PREGUNTAS PARA DIALOGAR

La cananea era una mujer marginada en la sociedad en que vivió Jesús, por su sexo, su raza y su religión. ¿Has experimentado el rechazo debido a tu sexo, raza o religión? ¿Qué hiciste para superarlo? ¿Se te ha pedido alguna vez ayudar a una persona de otra raza o cultura? ¿Cómo has respondido? ¿Cómo son tratadas las mujeres en la sociedad? Todos debemos imitar la actitud de Jesús hacia la cananea, él la aceptó por lo que era, una mujer extranjera.

## **Pope Francis Five Finger Prayer**



1. The thumb is the closest finger to you. So start praying for those who are closest to you. They are the persons easiest to remember. To pray for our dear ones is a "sweet obligation."
2. The next finger is the index. Pray for those who teach you, instruct you and heal you. They need the support and wisdom to show direction to others. Always keep them in your prayers.
3. The following finger is the tallest. It reminds us of our leaders, the governors and those who have authority. They need God's guidance.
4. The fourth finger is the ring finger. Even that it may surprise you, it is our weakest finger. It should remind us to pray for the weakest, the sick or those plagued by problems. They need your prayers.
5. And finally we have our smallest finger, the smallest of all. Your pinkie should remind you to pray for yourself. When you are done praying for the other four groups, you will be able to see your own needs but in the proper perspective, and also you will be able to pray for your own needs in a better way.
