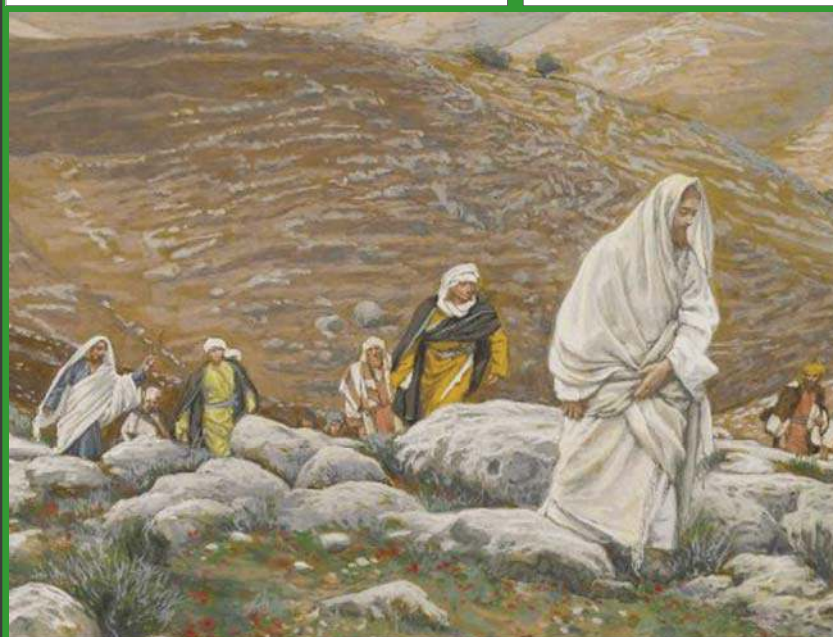

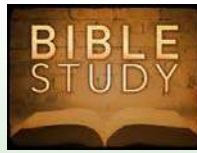
Sacred Conversations

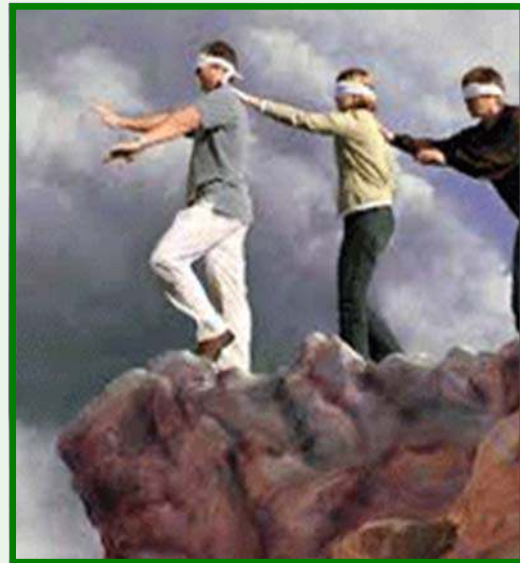

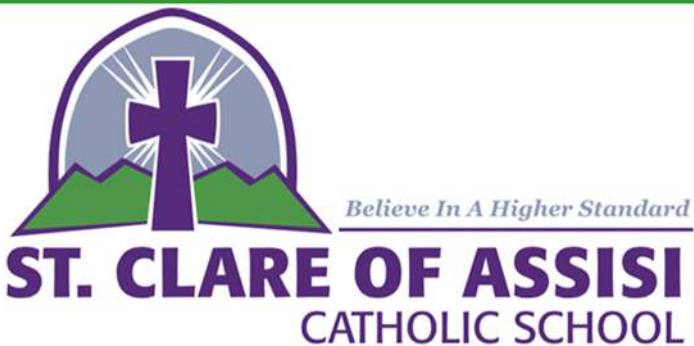
