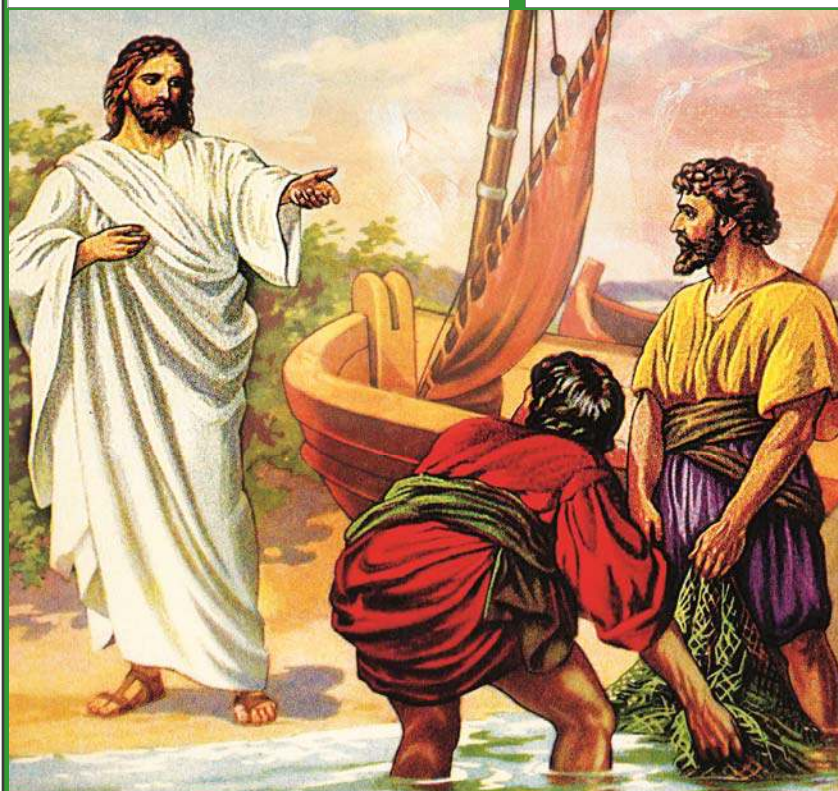

Sacred Conversations

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

What does it take to make an adult cry? For me, it's always the experience of the nearness of God. Take those guys on the shore of the Galilee, for example. They fished that sea all night and came back with nothing. Just a word from Jesus, though, and the fish came racing into the nets, begging to be caught up in the great Mystery.

When Simon Peter saw this, he broke down. *Get away from me, Rabbi. You don't know me, and once you do you won't want anything to do with me.* That's usually everyone's response when they have a God-sighting, a moment of such grace that, along with tears, comes the sense that someone else should have received this, someone better, someone worthier, someone who is...well...not us.

Don't worry, says Jesus. This was just a practice catch. From now on you and I are going to be hauling in people, billions and billions of them. So don't stress about your insufficiencies. My grace is sufficient.

You see, Jesus knows where all the fish are. He knows where to place the boats, way out in the deep. He knows where your wounds are, your losses, and your doubts. It's never in the shallows, but in the deep memories, that sadness festers.

Do you feel like you've fished all night long for a job, for friends, for love, for healing? Jesus sees you. He knows where you are in the big Sea. He wants to comfort you, to reel you into his net of communion and compassion. It's never about being worthy. It's about being welcomed.

Let Jesus catch you in his net. It's the safest place in the sea.

In what ways have you experienced the nearness of God?

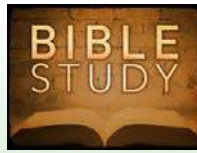

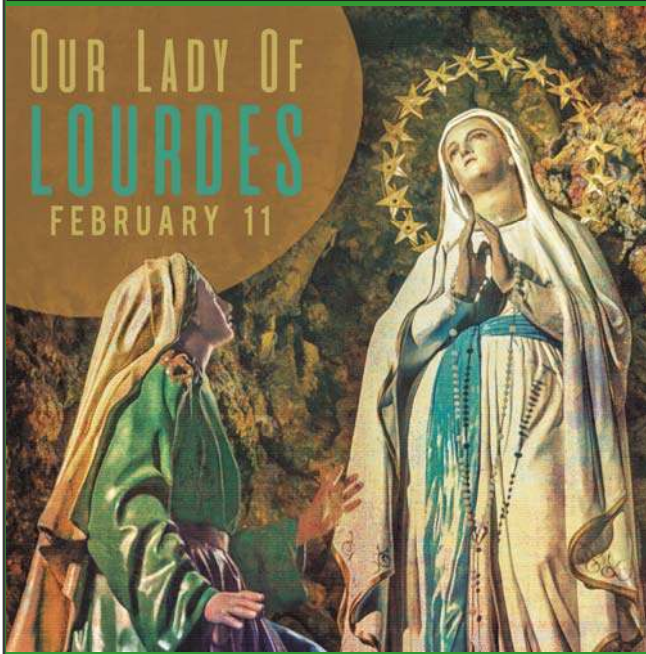

BREVE HISTORIA DE SAN VALENTÍN (PATRONO DE LOS ENAMORADOS)

Nació en Interamna Terni, unos 100km al norte de Roma, cerca del año 175. Fue ordenado **sacerdote** por San Felicio de Foligno y consagrado **obispo** de Interamna por el Papa Víctor I c. 197. Famoso por su evangelización, milagros y curaciones, este sacerdote ejerció en Roma durante el siglo III bajo el gobierno del Emperador Claudio II quien prohibía la celebración de matrimonios entre los jóvenes. El gobernante decía que: "Los solteros sin familia son mejores soldados, ya que no tienen ataduras."

Valentín consideró que el decreto era injusto y desafió al emperador celebrando en secreto matrimonios para jóvenes enamorados. El emperador Claudio se enteró y como el sacerdote gozaba de un gran prestigio en Roma, lo llamó al Palacio. Valentín aprovechó la ocasión para hacer proselitismo del cristianismo y aunque en un principio Claudio II mostró interés, el Gobernador de Roma llamado Calpurnio lo persuadió y el emperador optó por su encarcelación. Ocurrió que el oficial Asterius, encargado de encarcelarlo lo quiso ridiculizar y lo puso a prueba. "Te reto a que devuelvas la vista a mi hija Julia que nació ciega". Valentín aceptó e impuso sus manos sobre los ojos de la joven. "En el nombre del Señor y de su infinito amor, te devuelvo la vista". En el nombre de Jesús, se obró el milagro.

Este hecho convulsionó a Asterius y su familia, quienes se convirtieron al cristianismo. Valentín siguió preso, no pudieron liberar al sacerdote pues el débil emperador lo mandó a arrestar por temor a un levantamiento de los paganos y del ejército romano. De todas formas **fue torturado y decapitado el 14 de febrero del año 270**. Lo mataron de noche y en secreto para evitar la reacción del pueblo de Terni donde era muy amado. Como agradecimiento, Julia plantó un almendro de flores rosadas junto a su tumba y partir de entonces el

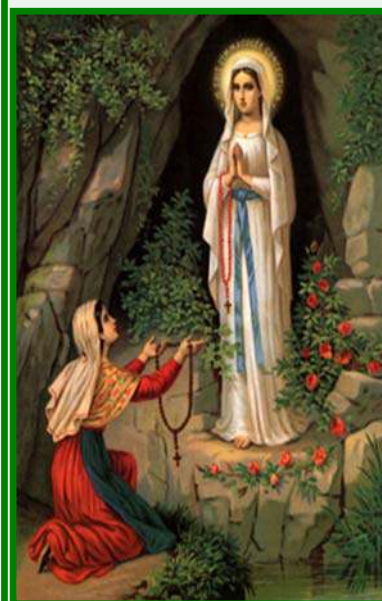

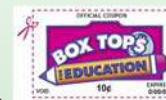

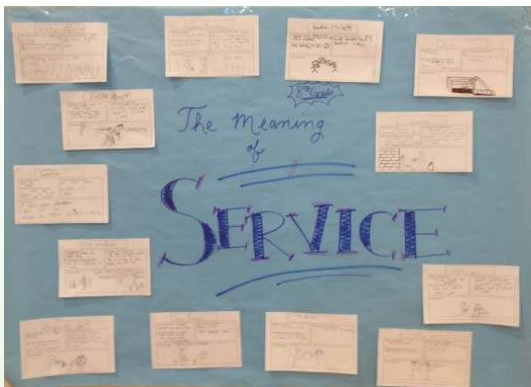
