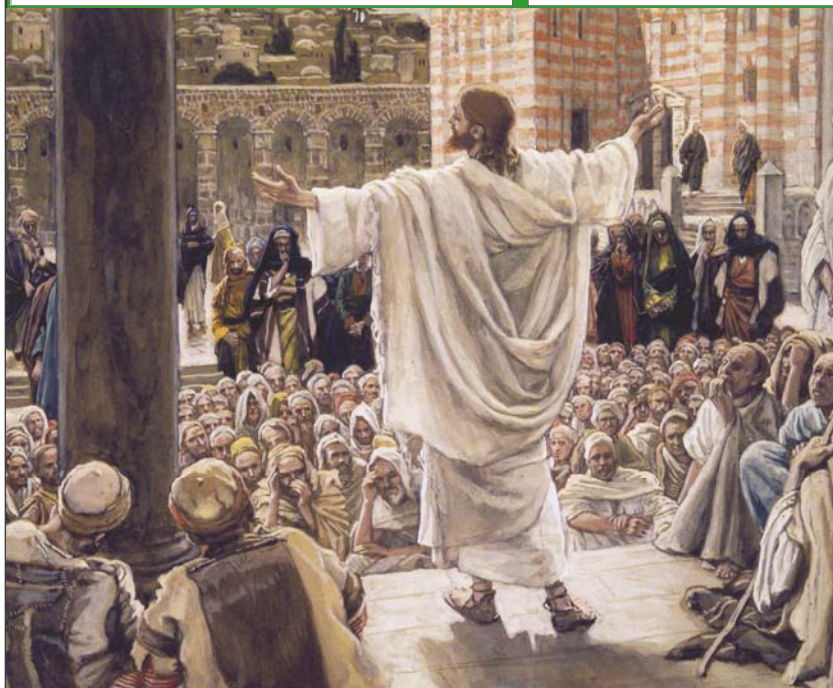

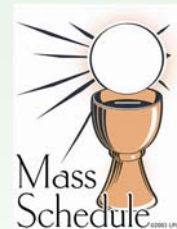

Sacred Conversations

### Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Somehow we think the people we call "prophets" were immune to pain, loneliness, or terror. Not so. Jeremiah, whose miserable time in the cistern is related in today's reading, wanted to be loved, not reviled. God duped him, he said, and he let himself be duped (Jer. 20:7).

Of all the prophets in the Old Testament, his life was the most similar to Jesus. Both were reviled by their enemies, and even their friends. Both so aggravated the religious authorities that they were watched, in hopes that, through carefully laid traps, they could be revealed as hypocrites and frauds. Both were thought to be worthy of death.

Jeremiah prophesied the destruction of Jerusalem to the kings and people of Judah. This was terrifying! Surely no army would ever breach the walls of the city that housed God's own Temple!

The prophets who counseled calm were much beloved, and ate in the palace. Jeremiah? Him they tossed him in a cistern. And this is where we see the big difference between Jeremiah and Jesus. While he once spoke on behalf of his adversaries, when his own life was severely threatened Jeremiah began to pray for their demise.

And Jesus? From the cross, he spoke on behalf of his murderers, asking that they be forgiven, for they knew not what they were doing.

In retrospect, we all wish we'd listened to the true prophets in our lives. We remember the guidance from parents and teachers, and wonder why we didn't heed their advice more attentively. And now we stand before God on behalf of our own children, who aren't listening all that carefully either. And so the world goes.

What prophetic words have you heard, and ignored, and now wish you'd taken to heart?

## DIA DE NUESTRA PATRONA SANTA CLARA DE ASIS DOMINGO 11 DE AGOSTO



### BIOGRAFIA

Cuando Clara tenía 18 años, subyugada por el ardor evangélico de su compatriota San Francisco de Asís (que acababa de poner en marcha la nueva fraternidad), Clara se confió a su dirección: abandonó su casa, y en la capilla de la Porciúncula, donde vivía San Francisco, tomó el hábito de manos del santo, prometiéndole obediencia.

Inmediatamente fue confiada por Francisco al monasterio benedictino de San Pablo de las Abadesas. Allí tuvo Clara que vencer la enconada oposición de sus parientes. Quince días después, Francisco le procuró un asilo más seguro en el convento de Sant'Angelo in Panzo, en las estribaciones del monte Subasio, donde fue a unírsele, fugada también clandestinamente, su hermana Inés.

Posteriormente, San Francisco dispuso para Clara y sus imitadoras una vivienda, adaptada al ideal de pobreza y sencillez que ella misma anhelaba, junto a la pequeña iglesia de San Damián, restaurada por el santo. Y en ella se instaló el pequeño grupo de Damas Pobres, llamadas luego Clarisas, formado inicialmente por Clara de Asís y otras tres compañeras.

La comunidad femenina imitaba en lo posible la de los hermanos franciscanos.

Durante cuarenta años, Clara fue la superiora del convento de monjas de San Damián. Su vida era de gran austeridad y muy rica en obras de caridad y piedad. Se cuenta que alejó con sus oraciones a los sarracenos que asediaban la población de Asís.

Santa Clara de Asís escribió una *Forma de vida* en la que insistía en la pobreza y que fue la base para la regla que ella misma redactó con posterioridad (1247-1252), adaptación para las religiosas de la regla franciscana. En 1253, una bula pontificia aprobaba solemnemente la regla que había compuesto. Murió en 1253 y fue canonizada en 1255. Sus restos descansan en la cripta de la iglesia dedicada a la santa en Asís. Su fiesta se celebra el 11 de agosto.

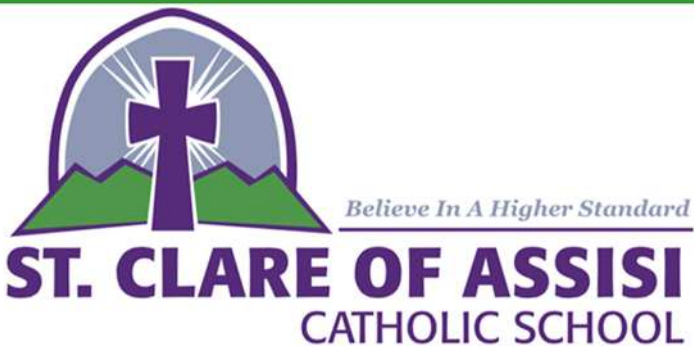

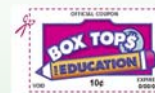

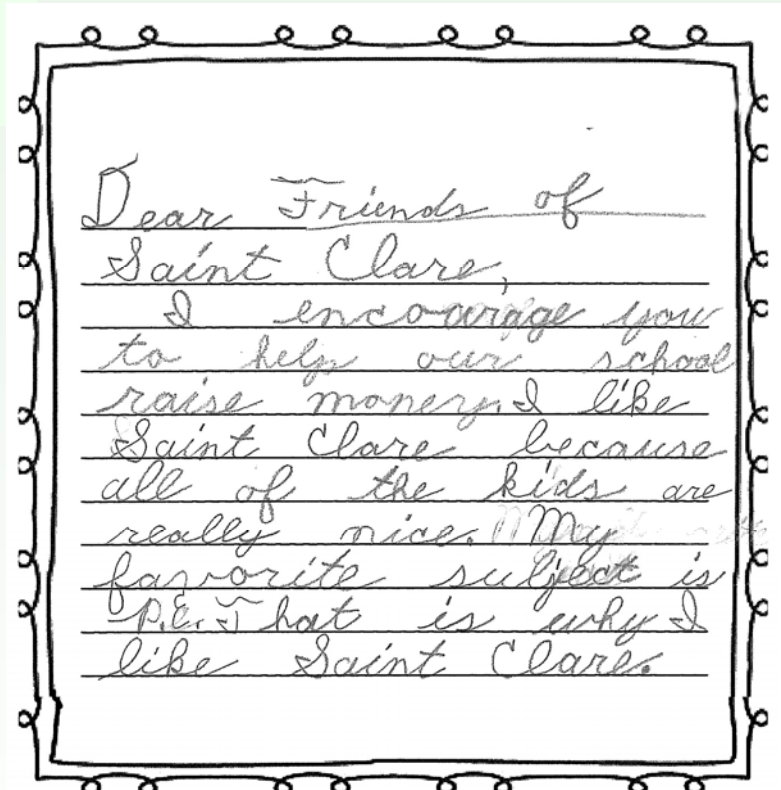
