Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Here's the thing about calling Jesus King, and embracing him as King. There has never been a less kingly presence. He is so completely different---radically at odds with, really---the Kings that murdered and oppressed and enslaved the Jews living in Jerusalem on the day of the crucifixion of our King.

What kind of King is this? He never lays a hand on anyone except to heal and comfort. He could call upon heaven's armies to take him from the cross and lay waste to those who tortured him, but instead he surrenders his beautiful life and is executed between two thieves.

What kind of King is it whose army is comprised of women, shepherds, the healed, the healing, the helpless, the short tax collectors, the defiant Syro-Phoenician women who will stand up to the King and demand healing for their daughters?

What kind of King tells his servants to go out and gather all who are poor to come to the banquet, even when it means going quickly to the streets to bring in the unwashed, the uncouth, the addicts, the drains on the system?

What kind of King is born in a barn, whose appearance is heralded in the heavens, whose Mother holds all the mysteries of his birth and life deeply in her heart?

I can promise you this: there is no King like this in any other religious imagination but that of the Christian faith. He is the King whose execution on the cross is the sacramental we wear. The crucifix is our entrée into the Kingship of Jesus.

What kind of King is that? He's my King. He's your King, and he shall reign forever and ever.

How does the Kingship of Jesus define your life in him?
